



The SCVF partners with ten affiliates to cover over 7,000 square miles in six counties. The SCVF administers 166 Donor Advised funds totaling 9.5 million dollars. These SCVF funds have awarded over 6,000 grants totaling 20.6 million dollars to area non-profits allowing fund-holders to support the people, programs places they love. The **SCVF** and implements foundation-led competitive grant programs directed to local community needs.

Chisago Lakes Community Foundation is an affiliate of the SCVF. The Chisago Lakes Area Community Foundation was established in 2008 with a purpose to build permanently endowed funds that will generate income. That income will help enhance new projects and initiatives through annual grants to groups and citizens of the area. They invite and encourage grant applicants every August. They are awarded to support projects that have broad community impact. The Applications are reviewed by a committee and the winners are announced in the local paper.
