With the opening of school brings our summer construction season to almost a close as well, but now we will move into a "school year" construction season. Unlike other projects in years past, these projects will continue well into 2019! Our Wildcat Community Center project began in earnest immediately after school let out in June. With the rain of the summer we did lose critical time, but we are still scheduled to open in spring 2019.

We have over 90 percent of all footings completed along with our new student parking lot coming to completion (if the rain ever stops!) Our new ag science and manufacturing spaces are taking shape but were also delayed by water - both the rain and from multiple leaks in our Community Aquatics Center. We spent the summer repairing those and are in good shape for the foreseeable future.

The new CL tennis and pickle ball courts opened in July and have had many users already on a daily basis. We feel extremely fortunate, proud, and blessed to have had the support and commitment of the Chisago Lakes area for all of the district improvements. The entire




