GENERAL SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Due to the 2014 enactment of MN Statutes 157.22, participants of the Celebration of the Lakes Chili Contest are exempt from obtaining a Food License to serve prepared chili during this event. We insist that you refer to the MDH Food Preparation Guidelines to ensure your chili is prepared, handled and served properly: https://www.health.state.mn.us/communities/environment/food/docs/pwdu/chilickofffs.pdf
- Meat/Poultry/Fish used in chili must be USDA graded or have been processed (wild game) at a licensed processing facility.
- NO Crockpots, Steam Tables, or Chafing Dishes—18 quart roaster ovens are recommended.
- One 18 quart roaster will hold 144/4 ounce servings.
- Chili must remain at a temperature of 140 degrees F, or above, for the entire serving duration to prevent bacteria growth.
- All participants are required to display a label that will be provided by Trinity Lutheran Church. This MUST be
